Found 1/2" iron rod as referenced in No. 2 above. I accepted this location as the original corner position based on the best available evidence. Found no apparent conflicting monumentation. I established the true corner location on the Standard Township Line between corners L-13 and K-13, T6N-R1W. The true corner location is 0.19 North of the ½" rerod. The rerod was removed in installing the new monument.
