- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- J-7; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 14 and 23, T40N, R29W;


Found a 1" x 42" galvanized iron pipe with a 4" brass cap as set by Mr. DeLaMater in 1954 inside of a 2" diameter iron pipe, firmly set, projecting 20" above the ground. Mr. DeLaMater's monument was found to be in agreement with his new bearing trees as described in Part A. Replaced Mr. DeLaMater's monument with a standard county monument described in Part C. Accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- J-7; One-quarter Corner common to Sections 14 and 23, T40N, R29W;

Drove the 2" diameter iron pipe to a point 4" above the ground and set on the south side a 5/8" x 36" aluminum rod with a 3" aluminum cap stamped as to location.

(i) is a DeLaMater new bearing tree and is further described in Part A. (ii), (iii), and (iv) are marked with upper and lower blazes. The lower blaze is scribed "NBT". Both blazes as well as a band around the tree at the upper blaze are painted red.
