A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(J2) Center of Section 2. Not established in the original survey.

(I2) Quarter corner common to Sections 2-3. Established in 1849 by James Mullett: North between Sec. 2 & 3...30.00 Summit 50 feet. 35.50 Begin to descend. 40.00 Set quarter section post, Birch 6 S26E 13, Birch 6 S68W 18. 42.20 Brook 02 rapid C SE at foot of hill 50 feet...88.40 intersected 4th Correction Line and set post.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:


(J2) Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/4 corners.

(I2) Original post and accessories were not recovered. This mile measures 310' longer than the original record. The topographical features along the southerly 50 chains of this line check roughly with the record. Substantial differences with the record were observed along the portion to the north, where the terrain becomes more severe. I believe that the original measurements were poorly made, particularly in the rougher northern 1/2 mile of this line. Consequently, I do not proportion the excess throughout the mile but rather reestablish the corner at record distance south (2.20 chains) from the creek bed noted in the record at 42.20 chains, and on a line of mean true bearing between closing corner 3414.1 ft. north and section corner 2731.0 ft. south.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(J2) Set 1" ID iron pipe with 4" aluminum MDNR cap. Blazed and scribed:  
 9" Cedar N86E 37.4' C1/4 BT"  
 12" Cedar S24E 19.8' do  
 9" Cedar S71W 41.9' do  
 8" Cedar N06W 26.8' do  
 Sqd cedar post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic. Distances are to notch in lower blaze.

(I2) Set 1" ID iron pipe with 4" aluminum MDNR cap. Blazed and scribed:  
 5" Aspen N01W 12.1' \* 1/4S N8T"  
 6" Sugar S78E 27.2' \* do  
 6" Sugar S53E 26.7' do  
 3" R. Maple S43W 15.6' do  
 Placed sqd sugar post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic. \*=slope distance. Distances are to notch in lower blaze.
