Szyszkoski . in a field survey on \_ Moyember 09, 1994 . , 19 . do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below

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A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(A5) Corner common to Sections 7-18 T42M-R28M, and Sections 12-13 T42M-R29M. Corner established in 1846 by John and Austin Burt as follows: "80.00 Set post corner of Sections 12813. Cedar 6 S 41M 10, Hemlock 14 M32M 51, Cedar 10 S19E 35" Found no subsequent

(3-Sec. 18) Morth 1/16 corner between Section 18 T42M-R28M and Section 13 T42M-R29M. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;

(A5) Original post and accessories were not recovered. Found no evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Found so evidence of subsequent monumentation. Reestablished the corner by proportionate measurement to the original record, on a straight line between Section corner 5282.1' north and Section corner 10564.2' south. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1'1,0,x32' iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MOMR tablet, appropriately stamped.

(3-Sec. 18) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between Section and quarter corners 1320.51' north and south. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1 [.D.x32' iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDHR tablet, appropriately stamped. The corner falls in a prairie opening which extendes about 200' east, 200' west, 50' north, and 150' south from the corner.
