Placed 1° pipe with 4° brass Michigan Dept. of Conservation cap and the following MBTs: 24° M. Pine stump N77E 36 links, 7° Balsam S74W 54 links. Buckler noted original W. Fine bearing tree stumps S54W 41 links, and H27E 48 links. Found no subsequent record.

8. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(A3) Found and accepted Buckler's monument as described, at record bearing and distance from his 1957 witnesses: the W. Pine stump now rotted, the balsam in good condition. Recovered the original BT stump noted by Buckler M27E 31.7' in proper relation to the corner. Left the monument in place and marked 4 new bearing trees as described below.
