DESCRIPTION OF CORNER MONUMENT 1" iron pipe with 4" brass cap. -----

WITNESSES TO CORNER Cedar 16" N 30 E 29 links marked 1/4 S NBT -----

Cedar 12" N 70 W 26 1/2 links, marked 1/4 S NBT -----

Cedar 10" S 56 W 32 links, marked 1/4 S NBT -----

Distances measured from center of brass cap to NBT notch.

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR
RESTORED.

This corner was replaced from one original cedar bearing tree 10" N 37 E 10 links down, in fair condition. Scribe marks plain on both description and BT blaze, and from one original cedar bearing tree 12" S 54 W 27 links in poor condition, down and badly rotted. Found axe marks in remains but no scribe marks.

Corner was found while examining road application in this area, with Clarence Ryberg.

Corner was placed and witnessed on 28 October 1958 with Norman J. Karsten.
