A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

E-5 Wood Post Y. Birch 18 S32E 26 lks. Y. Birch 12 N64W 32 lks.  
1 inch Iron Pipe set by persons unknown.

F-5 Wood Post Cedar 6 N24W 25 lks. Y. Birch 12 S20E 35 lks.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

E-5 Found a 1 inch iron pipe with a old broken-down fence running  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile north and a quarter mile to the east. Pipe is also on the extended centerline of the old county road from the west. Accepted iron pipe as the Section corner and replaced it with a Dickinson County Survey cap and rod.

F-5 No evidence of original corner or accessories found. Set Quarter corner by proportionate measurement at the mid-point and on line between the section corners  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the east and west.
