- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- C5 Section corner common to Sections 7, 8, 17 & 18, T17N, R2E Fd. 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" iron pipe Up 0.5'. Corner on Sand ridge. Measured S40°E 14'± to centerline remains of 28" Pine stump that is the apparent remains of witness #1. Nothing conclusive found at witnesses #2, just some burnt pine wood. The 36" WPS (#3) noted by Ostling is probably a Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) witness but there are no records in the CCC book to confirm this. Accepted the DNR Monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- C5 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" iron pipe. Add sand mound around monument. Set Blue Carsonite Post 1' South.
