I, Richard L. Drahn in a field survey on April 28, 19 97, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt in 1847. Original B.T.s --- Hemlock 10" S.35 W. 14 links (9.2') --- 20" Hemlock N.55 E. 20 links (13.2') ---.

Corner restored by Earl Harrington in 1928 from the stump remains of the two original B.T.s. He set a standard State Line concrete, brass capped monument and established a new B.T.; Hemlock 12" S.66-15 W. 29.0 ft.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Recovered the standard brass capped concrete monument as described in Earl Harrington's notes. His hemlock B.T. is now a hemlock stump decayed to below ground line.

No evidence remains of William Burts B.T. @ S.35 W. The original B.T. @ N.55 E. is now a series of large root holes, species undetermined.
