A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt in 1847. Original B.T.s --- Sugar 14" N.43 E. (no dist.) --- Sugar 16" S.79 W. 9 links (5.94') ---

Corner restored by Earl G. Harrington from the stump of the original Sugar at S.79 W. 5.9 ft.. Stump was blazed and had measuring hack on it. He set a standard brass capped concrete monument and two new B.T.s --- Y. Birch 6" S.03-30 E., 15.8 ft. --- Hemlock 12" N.20-50 W., 20.1 ft.---

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Recovered the standard brass capped concrete monument as described in Earl G. Harringtons notes. His SE B.T. is now a series of root holes, species undetermined. His NW B.T. is now a 16-18" badly decayed Hemlock stump.

A shallow depression is all that remains of Birts SW B.T.
