Garske in a field survey on requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

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A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by Austin Burt, D.S. in 1851 intersect Lake at 65.55 ch. from which a: Cedar 14" Meander corner and Fir 8" \$50°E - 24 links

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I monumented the corner at a found wooden post set along a blue line on the east shore of Chaney lake. This corner location is consistent with GLO natural feature ties and appears to be in the logical location with occupation lines which are in harmony. Keeweenaw lands has been using this location for over 40 years. No evidence of the original bearing trees exists with the wood post being the best available evidence to monument the corner.

I set 3/4" dia. x 48" alum. rod with a 3 1/4" dia alum. cap stamped to identify the corner; from which I established the following:
