Mile Corner #4½, Mich.---Wisc. State Line

I, Richard L. Drahn in a field survey on May 21, 19 97,  
do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned  
in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the  
current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land  
Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5  
above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a  
Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as  
expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded  
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt in 1847. Original B.T.s --- Y. Birch  
10" S.22 E. 5 links (3.30') --- Cedar 10" N.35 W. 13 links (8.58') ---

Corner restored in 1928 by Earl G. Harrington from the two original B.T.s.  
The Y. Birch was a decayed stump and the Cedar was a live, 18" Cedar with  
scribing visible. He set a standard brass capped concrete monument and one  
new B.T.; --- Cedar 6" S.10-30 W. 21.8 ft.---

Research form on file with Gogebic County records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Recovered the 1928 standard brass capped concrete monument as described in  
Harringtons notes. The 1928 B.T. is now a 16" decayed Cedar windfall with  
GLO blaze under water.

No evidence remains of the 1847 Y. Birch B.T. The Cedar at N.35 W. is now  
a large windthrown decayed tree with GLO blaze.
