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

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt in 1847. Original B.T. --- Sugar 10" N. 75½ W. 685 links --- " no other bearing trees" ---

Corner re-established by Earl G. Harrington by proportionate methods in 1928 on a dependent re-survey of the State Line. He set a standard brass capped concrete monument two new B.T.s --- Y. Birch 8" S.48-40 W. 21.8' --- Y. Birch 8" N.37-36 E. 31.35' ---

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

Recovered the concrete monument as described in Harringtons notes and the following 1928 B.T.s: 12-14" downed Yellow Birch with portions of the blaze still intact at N.37½ E. 31.4' and a live 18" Yellow Birch with blaze and scribing grown ower at S.48½ W. 21.96' (new nail in side of B.T.)
