I, John R. Garske, in a field survey on December 7, 19 94,  
do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned  
in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the  
current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land  
Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5  
above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a  
Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as  
expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded  
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original survey by William Ives, Deputy Surveyor, in 1848. Original corner was a cedar post and  
original bearing trees are: Hemlock 18" - N25°E, 28 links (18.48'); Hemlock 26" - S9°W, 34  
links (22.44').

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence could be found. Corner position was re-established on the extension of the  
section line in conjunction with an ancient fence line west to the river's edge. The corner was  
placed at the top of bank so as to protect and preserve the integrity of the corner. This position  
matches G.L.O. call with measurement to the edge of the Montreal River.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum monument with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap stamped: County  
Remonumentation; T48N, R47W, M.C.; S-31; S-6; T47; 1994; RLS 28410. Established the  
following bearing trees and reference object: 8" twin hemlock east, 27.03 feet; 8" sugar - S35°E,  
50.14 feet; 5" sugar - S15°W, 13.05 feet; 6' steel rail with sign - N10°E, 2.36 feet.
