He placed a location poster on the NW side of a 10" Hemlock from which the Spruce stake lay N.28°W, 17 feet. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: I restored the corner position at record bearing and distance from the remains of the two original bearing trees. The first is a large series of root holes with Yellow Birch bark. The second one is now an almost completely decayed Sugar Maple stump. A 32" Yellow Birch witness tree, still scribed with a "W & N" bears N.60° E. 25.32' from the original corner location. The 1935 location poster was recovered on the NW side of a 17" Hemlock bearing S.24° E. 9.2'.
