No original evidence found.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Established the meander corner at the top of the bank overlooking Lake Superior on a line parallel with the south line of Section 1, running from the monumented section corner of Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12. No original or subsequent evidence of this corner could be found.

The corner was reestablished in this manner after we had tied in to several corners in the area and comparing bearings to each line. This line matches occupation lines used by area residents for many years.
