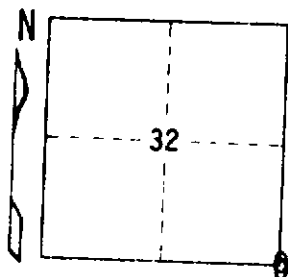

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

This corner was established at the position of a found 3" diameter Cedar post (2.5') deep), and from remains of USBT to SW (Cedar stump with part of lower face and notch intact), buried at side of swamp tote road.

This corner fits survey of Sec. 33 by E.P. WATERMAN, Sept. 1912, L.2-P.194.
