Remon.' brass cap on 2 ½ " X 30" galvanized iron pipe by single proportion between A7 & C7. Fits N-S ¼ line through B6 to B5. Fits Tuller's distance to B6 within 2'. 3 1/4 " brass cap on iron pipe accepted as a careful & faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

- Reference pt. - Found bent CPC 'T' iron - N49°49'W 17.21' of B7. This 'T' iron was established by single proportion using a erroneous position per M. Schaaf - N51°02'W 36.27' of A7.
