Fd nail in SW face of 10" Oak - S60°E - 33.76 ft and Fd nail in SE face - S15°W - 16.89 ft. and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Remonumented this position with a 21 x 30 flanged bottom galvanized iron pipe with a 31 brass cap. stamped Grand Traverse County Remonumentation.

Also found DNR monument with horseshoe shaped strap iron along side cedar post next to corner, allwitnesses from G,F. DeLamater and DNR intact, DNR surveyor Ken Ostling found iron and G.L.O. stumps and Act 74 recordings.
