A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

G-7 Corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 & 22

County Surveyor records: George Steele established corner with a stone in 1895. 1904 records list witnesses to stone. E. P. Waterman found fence post & stone in May 1906, April 1909 and September 1913.

Act 74 L.C.R. filed by Glenn F. DeLaMater witnessing stone.

Certificate of Survey by Wm. Richards references found stone in 1973.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

G-7 Corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21 & 22

Found stone per DeLaMater and Richards witnesses in an East-West fence line.

Found remains of a pine tree stump, an original witness by E. P. Waterman recorded in 1904.

Accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
