A-7 Corner common to Sections 18, 19, T.28N., R.10W. & Sections 13 & 24, T.28N., R.11W. County Surveyor records: Northrup, in 1900, finds stake & stones; set plow iron next to stake. Waterman, in 1909, finds stake & plow iron.

Sawyer, in 1952, references stake to plat of Woodland Terrrace, 124.3' West to monument; 138.62' North to monument. Distances check North and West. L.C.R. by Larry Gerschbacher in 1972.
