C-7: Corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20.

LCRC #104 files in 1976 by M. Koivisto-Found baroken off Railroad spike 3.7' North of centerline and on fence line north, replaced with 1/2" x 18" rebar. (O'Non, 1998)-Found 1/2" iron rod.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: C-7: Corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20.

Found 1/2" iron rod 4 feet North of centerline of Donner Road on fence line North and occupation line south fitting witnesses of record. 1/2" iron rod was accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner by the Leelanau County Remonumentation Peer Review Group on November 30, 1999, and remonumented with a 3/4"galvanized

iron pipe, 3' long, with a brass cap.
