I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on _____, 19____ do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(16) Quarter corner common to Sections 14-15. Corner reestablished in 1958 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS: "Reestablished 1/4 corner midway and on line between two section corners...corner monument 1" pipe with 4" brass cap, witnesses to corner 12" hard maple N17E 51 links, 14" Y. Birch S68W 102 links".

(15) Corner common to Sections 10-11-14-15. Corner remonumented in 1958 from two original B.T.s by Billy D. Buckler, RLS. Corner monument: 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. Witnesses to corner: 12" soft maple S29E 40 links, 14" cedar N36E 39 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(16) Found the 1958 monument as described, a 1" ID iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. brass MI Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the two 1958 NBTs. The maple is in good condition, the Y. Birch is down and rotten. Determined that the monument is about 16' Westerly of the straight line between adjacent section corners as they are now monumented. I accepted the monument, left it in place, and marked three new witnesses as described below. Corner rewitnessed by B.Wheeler, Baraga District Office.

(15) Found the 1958 monument as described, a 1" dia. iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. brass MI Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1958 accessories. The maple is dead and down, the cedar is green but leaning with a broken top. Left the monument in place and marked three new witnesses as described below. Corner rewitnessed by B.Wheeler, Baraga District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(16) Found 1" pipe with 4" brass MI Dept. of Conservation cap. Blazed and scribed the following:

10" Sugar S79E 13.1' "1/4S NBT"
14" Maple S30W 21.9' "1/4S NBT"
8" Sugar N53W 31.2' "1/4S NBT"

The 1958 NBT 20" Sugar N19E 33.6' found with old blazes. Bearings are magnetic. Distances to notch in lower blaze.

(15) Found 1" iron pipe with 4" brass cap. Blazed and scribed the following new bearing trees:

8" Y. Birch S76E 16.0' "S14 NBT"
8" Sugar S80W 28.2' "S15 NBT"
5" Sugar N30W 11.2' "S10 NBT"

The 1958 witness cedar 14" N46E 26.3'. Placed a maple post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic. Distances to notch in lower blaze.
