A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(CB) Quarter corner between Sections 19 and 20, TSIM-R36W. Corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor S.W. Higgins, 1848. Found no subsequent record.

116) East 1/16 between Sections 19 and 30, TSIN-R36W. Corner not established in original survey. Found no subsequent record.

(7) Morth 1/16 corner between Section 19 and 29, TSIM-R36W. Corner not established in original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(CB) Original post and accessories not recovered. Determined corner to be lost and reestablished the corner by single proportionate measure between recorded corners 2547.24' North and South. Found, but did not accept as the corner, an aleminum pipe with wood post adjacent bearing N41N, 136.8° from the reestablished corner. It appears that the pipe was placed at record bearing and distance from the south. Two blazes face the pipe but do not appear to be more than 15 years old.

(16) Established corner midway and on a straight line between adjacent recorded corners 89 and C9. Found no economentation or evidence of use at this position.

(7) Established corner midway and on a straight line between recorded corners C7 and C8. Found no monumentation or evidence of use at this position.
