I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 2 05/30/2012 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(L9) Quarter corner common to Sections 24 and 25. 1846 - Established by Deputy Surveyors Higgins and
Hubbard midway and on the Section line between Section corners 40.03 chains east and west. Set post.
Sugar 10" N44E 16 links, Sugar 12" S10W 11 links. Found no subsequent record.

(2-Sec. 25) East 1/16 corner between Sections 24 and 25. Not previously monumented.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(L9) The true bearing and distance of the line between K9 and M9 was found to be N83 deg. 58'12"E
4900.71 ft. (Rec. as East 5283.96'). Considering the possibility that the 1/4 may have been
'stubbed' out at record bearing and distance from either of the Section corners, a search was
conducted at both locations: Due east 40.03 chains east of K9 and Due west 40.03 chains west of M9.
No evidence of the position of the original corner was recovered at either of these locations, nor at
the single proportionate position for the corner - midway and on line between the Section corners. I
consider the original corner lost and reestablish it by proportionate measurement to the original
record, on the Section line between Section corners 2450.35' easterly and westerly.

(2-Sec. 25) Established the position for the corner midway and on the Section line between Section
corner 1225.17' east and Quarter corner 1225.17' west.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(L9) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
8" Maple N66W 1.1' mrkd "1/4S NBT"
18" Hemlock S70E 18.9' do
9" Maple S51E 10.75' do
4" Hemlock S12E 25.4' do
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.

(2) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
3" Hemlock N68E 17.65' mrkd "1/16S BT"
13" Maple S54E 37.1' do
6" Maple S02E 17.0' do
6" Balsam S63W 3.65' do
Set sq'd cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.
