

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - MC C5-D5 Z4: From original notes:East between Sections 8 & 17; 38.72 Intersected Keweenaw Bay. Set Meander post on ledge of sand rock about 70 feet high; fir 6 S71W 21; Cedar 8 N30W 17. No evidence of original corner or accessories
 - C5: Southwest Corner Section 8: From original notes: South between Sections 7 & 8; 80.00 Set post corner of Sections 7, 8, 17 & 18; Hemlock 14 N12E 25; Fir 12 S14W 43. No evidence of original corner or accessories
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

MC C5-D5 Z4: Found 1" pin, 13" A.G., 26 ' East to top of sandstone ledge. Fence line to West. Pin fits well with undated survey within Section 17, T53N-R32W by Steinhilb & Hesterberg. Recovered and used personally in a 1997 survey.

C5: Southwest Corner Section 8: Found ½" pipe in 9" cylinder of concrete, 6" B.G., 3.5' Easterly of centerline drive to fire # J-24, as recorded in Liber 2 of L.C.R.C., page 631. Witnesses of said record: 12" Spruce N30°W 24.18'; 8" Spruce S85°E 105.71'; 12" Spruce S4°E 93.09'; Util. Pole S34°W 44.18'; 1/2" rod in monument East 77.70'
