Geo. Mark, Mar. 17, 1871, Survey #597: Stone & Brick.

M.S.H.D., Dec. 1967: Found iron bar 0.5' below pvmt. raised with R.R. spike; 1.3' North of centerline M-34; N. 30° E. 65.17' bldg. cor.; S. 45° E. 83.92' bldg. cor.; S. 30° W. 60.00' fnc. Cor.; N. 35° W. 46.55' street sign.

LCRC L.1, P. 43, Sept. 7, 1971, A.J. Hatt: R.R. spike 2.0' North of centerline M-34; N.E. cor. Fed. Aid Tri. Conc. Marker S. 30°W. 57.2'; N.W. cor. old school house bldg. S. 45° E. 84.0'

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1-1/4" iron pipe in monument box and both of Hatt's references. Also found one M.S.H.D. reference.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 1/2"x 6" iron with remonumentation cap in 1-1/4" iron pipe in monument box and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

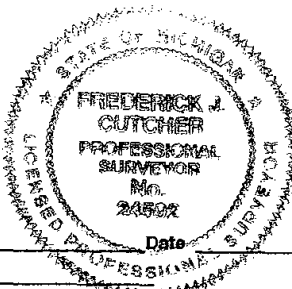
