B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Searched at probable location of the corner from witnesses above and found 3/4" pipe. Excavated around pipe to a depth of 2' and found nothing. Documented measurements from this corner are Fouty E2641.08'; Stephens E2639.72'; White E2641.12'; Lester E 2640.96'; Fouty W2626.19'; Lester W 2626.08'; Bryan W2626.08'; White W2626.19'; White S2645.59'; Lester S2645.98'. All of the historical witnesses cited in Section A are still present. Accepted 3/4" pipe as the perpetuated location of the corner from the above historical measurements and witnesses and replaced with standard bar and PA 345 cap #18989 in monument box.
