A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

G6 – ¼ corner common to sections 15 & 16, T26N, R5W

- 1852 –GLO Resurvey – Cannon – Set quarter sect. post. – 1) Maple 10" N23°E 26, 2) Maple 10" S30°W 19.
- 1913 – Fargo Engineering Map #3515 – No pipe set. No U.S. evidence.
- 1978 – Consumer's Power Co. Survey drawing #S-F17406 – D. Ankrom, PS #21265 – Found 1½" pipe with scribed post. – 3) 12" Ash S45°W 13.35', 4) 6" Ash S60°E 15.37', 5) 8" Birch N55°E 7.61', 6) 14" Ash N30°E 9.92'.
- 1980 – Certificate of Survey, L. 2, P. 601 – N. Parker, PS #16939 – No corner description – 3) 12" Ash S45°W 13.35', 4) 6" Ash S60°E 15.37', 5) 8" Birch N55°E 7.61', 6) 14" Ash N30°E 9.92'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

G6 – Found 1" X 2.3' long pipe. Found witnesses #3, #4 & #6 in good condition. Found birch stump (#5) fitting position of pipe. No GLO evidence was found. Accepted found pipe as the **best available evidence of the position of the original corner** and replaced it with a 4" stamped DNR aluminum cap on 1" X 36" galvanized iron pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

G6 – Stamped 4" DNR aluminum cap on 1" X 36" galvanized iron pipe.

N30°E 10.09' to set nail & tag at found nail in W. side 18" R. Maple (#6)
S60°E 15.41' to set nail & tag at found nail in SW. side 10" R. Maple (#4)
S45°W 13.59' to set nail & tag at found nail in NW. side 17" R. Maple (#3)
