I-3 Found standard Kent County Monument on C/L of 68th Street running E-W and 2.0' West of C/L of Burlingame Avenue
running N-S per L.C.R.C.'s #1541 and #6327 as set by Exxel Engineering in place of a 1" iron and stone they found which
