B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No corner marker found. Position of corner established by measuring between the two closest Van Buren County Section corners North and South, said corners being a 1½" pipe found at the East quarter corner, Section 13 (per 1901 W.H. Goss, D.C.S.) and a 1½" pipe found at the East quarter corner, Section 25 (per 1915 W.H. Goss, D.C.S.). The distance measured between said corners is 10,502.97 feet. Divided this measure into 4 equal half miles (10,502.97 ÷ 4 = 2625.74') and established position of Southeast corner, Section 24, Pine Grove Township at 2625.74 feet North of said East quarter corner, Section 25 and placed a 30" Harrison Monument at Southwest corner, Section 19, Alamo Township North at the government jog of 23.10'. Said Southwest corner, Section 19 is on line between said East quarter corner, Section 13, Pine Grove Township and the East quarter corner, Section 25, Pine Grove Township. Measured South to West quarter corner, Section 30, Alamo Township (said West quarter corner being 28 lks. North of East quarter corner, Section 25, Pine Grove Township per 1902 information) at 2630.36'.
