- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- 1827 Corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Robert Clark, Jr. W. Oak 14" S 71°W 26 lks. W. Pak 10" N 8°E 19 lks.
- 1888 -F. Hodgman "Road heavily graded. It is said R. Nutting set rock bounds here but I could not find it. Set post N 55 1/2° E 100 lks. from stump of what appears to be the U.S. bearing tree. It agrees well with the center lines of roads both ways as occupied. Maple 3" N 37 E 167 1/2 lks. Apple 8" S 381/2*E 1281/2.

1908 - Ed Strong - "Found tile"

1958 - KCRC plans (Q Ave.) "Never found marker const. centerline witnessed. SE 129.75 SW 69.75 NW 102.92 NE 98.30 } Could be stakes, SERVICE OF MICHIGAR spikes & tabs or marks on fence".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original monument and accessories not recovered.

LAND SURVINGE LAND SURVINGE 1998: Found P.K. Nail in 2" dia. pipe directly over an 81/2" long 1/4" dia. rod - very old. Excavated a 5' (E & W) x 9' (N & S) x 7' deep hole. Dug through 30" of fill then into clean sand to bottom of excavation. No evidence of tile or previous disturbance. Road area cut in NE & NW quadrants of intersection and filled in SW & SE quadrants.

- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- K-7, Southwest Corner of Section 13, Town 3 South, Range 10 West. Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on December 17, 1998. Location of the found p.k. nail and 1/4" dia. rod is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the corner. Set a 30" Harrison Monument in a monument box in place of the p.k. nail and 1/4" rod.
