B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Original Corner Post & Accessories not recovered.

Found 3/8" iron bar in monument box in centerline E-W road directly over drill stone 1.3' deep, checks corner location as described by MDOT and as described and recorded by T. Chettleburgh.

The 3/8" iron bar and drill stone was accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner and was ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on April 21, 1994.
