I, Glenn E. Richard in a field survey on April 18, 2000,
 do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned
 in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the
 current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land
 Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5
 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a
 Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as
 expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

G.L.O. 1824 John Mack D.S. set 1/4 Sec. post in swamp Poplar 6 N 11 E 113 no other tree near
 1943 Walter Frazier survey called for "large end post - W 1/4 post Sec. 5"
 1960 Kenneth Suydam while employed by Walter Frazier did the field work on a survey for Fred Older who was a civil
 engineer and Mr. Frazier gave him the field notes and he did the computations and wrote the descriptions that begin at
 the east 1/4 corner of Section 6. The notes call for "Old corner post"
 1986 I found a 3/4" iron pipe in swamp with coupling on the top & pieces of tile in remains of old wood post which
 checked ± location of the 1960 survey
 1991 I found 1/2" iron pipe in swamp with coupling on the top and recorded it in Liber 5, Page 220

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

April 18, 2000 I found the 3/4" iron pipe which checked the one remaining witness.
 Replaced the found iron pipe with a 30" Harrison Monument. I found a stone on the west side of the remains of a
 Cedar post 1' under the water. Had to remove the stone to set the Harrison Monument. I placed stones and pieces of tile
 around the monument to hold it in place as the muck was saturated with water. I found a 3/4" galv. pipe in fence row
 368.07' east. (No occupation north) W.E.F. 1943 survey record=364.98.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

30" Harrison Monument and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

 Dbl hd nail & disc in 12" Box Elder West 25.40
 Dbl. hd nail & disc in 10" Box Elder S 45° E 16.47
 Carsonite post North 0.38
