

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

I-4/5 (South) Witness Corner to the Meander Corner Common to Sections 10 & 11, T45N, R10W, on the South Side

of Twin Lakes.

1849 – Original corner established by William Ives, 17.50 chains (1155 feet) north of the section corner at I-5.

Cadar 10 N87°W 12 links – Cedar 10, S12°E 13 links.

Found no evidence of subsequent restoration of this corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

UMEN This corner is being reestablished as part of the Luce County Remonumentation Program. Found no evidence of the original comer. Reestablished corner 1112 feet north of the Section corner at I-5, on line between said Section corner at I-5 and the reestablished meander corner on the North side Twin Lakes. This position is 46.6 feet south the pro-rated position for the meander corner, which now falls in Twin Lakes.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a ½" x 36" rebar with a stamped aluminum Luce County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, which falls on the northeasterly shore of the southerly peninsula of Twin Lakes.

Nail and plastic witness tag #33142 in blazed 7" Cedar in clump, N73°W 18.44'
