I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 09/15/14 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C9) Corner common to Sections 19-20-29-30. 1952 - Monumented in the original position and subsequently recorded in 1953 by Dean C. DeLaMater RLS. "One original B.T. still in place, down, fair condition". Set 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. 10" J.Pine S20°E 10 links. Found no subsequent record.

(15-Sec. 20) West 1/16 corner between Sections 20 and 29. Not previously monumented.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C9) The 1952 monument was not recovered and has likely been removed by heavy equipment as it falls just 3' east of an old logging road. Found the 1952 NBT J. Pine dead but in good condition with measuring notch visible. Found the point of the squared post which would have been set adjacent to the monument. Remonumented the corner at record bearing (corrected for declination change by indexing 1952 rec. bearings against observed bearings at corner D9) and distance from the J.Pine NBT, which position is also S16°E 0.5' from the recovered post point. The original B.T. noted in the 1952 record (being a Y.Pine 16" N56E 17 links) is now a stump mound at record bearing and distance.

(15-Sec. 20) Established the position for the corner midway and on the Section line between Quarter corner 1317.65' east and Section corner 1317.65' west.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(C9) Set 1"IDx28" I.pipe with 2" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:  
7" J.Pine N84°E 55.33' mrkd "S20 NBT"  
10" J.Pine N11°E 18.00 do  
8" J.Pine N82°W 28.34' "S19 NBT"  
6" J.Pine S01°W 29.22' "S30 NBT"  
E= 8126593.437 N= 215327.940

(15) Set 1"IDx28" I.pipe with 2" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:  
10" Oak S66°E 2.72' mrkd "W1/16 BT"  
9" W.Pine S02°E 16.23' do  
9" Oak S63°W 17.62' do  
9" W.Pine N04°E 23.15' do
