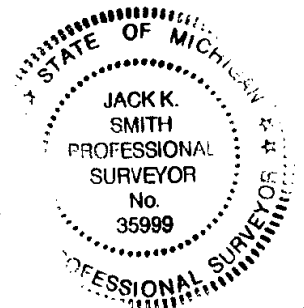
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

THE EXISTING CORNER IS A CAPPED 1/2" REROD 1 FOOT BELOW THE SURROUNDING GROUND AT THE INTERSECTION OF FENCE REMAINS AND TREE ROWS NORTH, SOUTH, EAST AND WEST. THIS APPEARS TO BE THE ONLY CORNER USED SINCE AT LEAST 1979.
