M-07 T3N - R6E: NORTHEAST CORNER, SECTION 24, HARTLAND TOWNSHIP

This Corner falls in Dunham Lake. The corner was originally recorded by Sibley as falling in the lake. The monumentation in the various Dunham Lake Estates Subdivisions does not fit well with the plat documents, but we were able to find what appears to be the original monument for the northwest corner of "Dunham Lake Estates South" in the fence around the park area on the south end of the lake. We also found a monument and irons on the north end of Dunham Lake that appear to mark the easterly boundary of "Dunham Lake Estates". In the Oakland County plat of "Dunham Lake Estates #1" there is a 00°01'40" deflection in the line shown at the Northwest Corner of Section 19, T3N, R7E. Extension of the line from the Northwest Corner of Section 24 through the North 1/4 Corner of Section 24 falls 36 feet southerly of the 1/2 distance point. The extension of the centerline of Dunham Road to the east falls 0.81 feet southerly of the midpoint, but if extended westerly falls 32.20 feet north of the North 1/4 Corner of Section 24. Extension of the 1/4 Corners to the north and south of corner M-07 through the plat monuments to the 1/2 distance point (at M-07) miss each other by 1.12 feet. By taking the midpoint of the intersections the plat monuments would fall 0.2-0.3 feet off of matching the County line and the deflection at corner M-07 would be 5.32 feet (see sketch). After discussion by members of the Peer Group it was felt that the best compromise for the location of the corner would occur by using the found monumentation along the township line to redefine the east-west location of corner M-07, and an extension of line from Corner L-07 through the northeasterly corner of Dunham Lake Estates South would best agree with the apparent historical

Lake Estates South would best agree with the apparent historical usage of the North line of Section 24. We will set reference monuments north, south and west of Dunham Lake as recommended and approved by the Peer Group.
