A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

GLO: 1825

White Oak 35", South 76 degrees West, 10 links

White Oak 32", North 72-1/2 degrees East, 37 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1/2" iron rod, when excavated to set remonumentation pipe, found Munsell & Garlock iron below this iron at 2.0 ft. below grade.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

D-11, T4N, R3E, CONWAY, replaced existing 1/2" iron for corner with 1-1/4" X 36" iron pipe, affixed with 2" dia. brass cap, stamped "Livingston Co. Monumentation Corner, P.S. 19834, set in road box, and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

D-11, THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29 AND THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32.

FIELD: 6-24-1996 DARRELL D. HUGHES AND ASSOCIATES, FOWLERVILLE.

Found a 1/2" iron rod, 0.2' below grade and 1.5' North of centerline asphalt pavement. Also, found a PK nail 0.5' South of centerline and 2.25' SE from iron rod. In 1972, Oscar Boss finds 3/8" iron and shows 3 witness points. In 1991 Hughes finds PK nail with witness' checking to 1972 ties, does not mention 3/8" or 1/2" iron. Measures from PK, East to E-11 agree with Boss' 1979 measurement and West to C-11 also agree with same. Measures North to D-10 vary. The 1/2" iron rod agrees with irons found for Boss survey North and East of corner. I recommend the acceptance of the 1/2" iron for the position of D-11. OK for GPS.
