

COHOCTAH H-13

On April 12th, 1823 a wood post was set by John Mullett to mark this standard corner. There were no County Surveyors records found pertaining to this point nor was there any useful documentation on the public record relating to the location of this corner.

There are large acreage parcels on both the north and south side of the township line in this vicinity that extend west from Byron Road past the 1/4 line and to the edge of the Shiawassee River in the SW 1/4 of Section 34 and the NW 1/4 of Section 3 to the south. On September 28th, 1994, fieldcrews made a search of the area but found nothing marking the corner. There were no fences to indicate possession at either this quarter corner or the closing quarter corner for the township to the south.

Consequently, we propose to establish this quarter corner at the midpoint of a straight line from standard corners G-13 and I-13. Closing corner G-1 for the township on the south would fall 0.08 south of this line, and the iron in the centerline of Byron Road ostensibly set to mark the township line would fall 0.05' south of this line.
