A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

L-5 Common 1/4 Corner, Sections 12 & 13, T4N-R4E, Cohoctah Township, Livingston County

1823 Wood post placed by Sylvester Sibley, Deputy Surveyor, two witness trees were marked at this time, N41 1/2W 14 links 18" W. Oak and S53E 27 links 16" W. Oak.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

L-5 Common 1/4 Corner, Sections 12 & 13, T4N-R4E, Cohoctah Township, Livingston County

Found no evidence of original government corner. Found 3" iron pipe in concrete at the base of a flat metal post, on fence lines running North-South and East-West, and on the North side of old two-track. Verified the position of the found pipe with witnesses and measurements from 1971 to present. Found no conflicting evidence in the vicinity of this position. We recommend that the found iron pipe be accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original government corner and a standard Livingston County brass cap be placed on pipe. Corner is not suitable for GPS.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

L-5 Common 1/4 Corner, Sections 12 & 13, T4N-R4E, Cohoctah Township, Livingston County

Set standard Livingston County brass cap stamped "L-5 39096" in concrete in existing 3" pipe.

East 1.30' Set Carsonite Survey Marker post  
South 13.80' Set nail with Livingston County Survey Witness Tag in West face of wood fence post  
S15W 29.48' Set nail with Livingston County Survey Witness Tag in West face 15" Oak  
N80W 45.82' Set nail with Livingston County Survey Witness Tag in South face of 24" Maple  
N60E 21.40' Set nail with Livingston County Survey Witness Tag in Northwest face of 6" twin Cherry
