(69) Corner common to Sections 21-22-27-28. Corner reestablished in 1979 by Billy D. Buckler, LS, and recorded in 1980. Corner monument is 36" T-iron, buried. Mitnesses to corner: 15" J. Pine M78E 41.6', 16" M. Pine S58E 36.0', Found north edge of a pine plantation, 12' to north, to east of here.
