I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on _____, 19____ do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(M3) Corner common to Sections 1-12 T44N-R11W and Sections 6-7 T44N-R10W. Corner reestablished in 1969 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS: "This corner placed in center of N-S road and on an old tree line to east and west. Corner lies 18' north of an old fence line to west and in line with old fence to east. Corner monument 1 1/4" iron pipe, buried in N-S road. 18" Hard Maple (N8T) N80W 41.9', 12" Hard Maple (N8T) N41W 51.1"

(M4) Quarter corner common to Section 12 T44N-R11W and Section 7 T44N-R10W. Corner reestablished in 1969 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS: "This corner re-established midway bet. two Sec. Cors. and in approx. center of an old N-S road. Found no evidence of any corner here. Cor. lies 39.0' north of an old E-W railroad grade. Corner monument 1 1/4" x 30" iron pipe, buried in center of N-S road. 8" Elm (1/4S N8T) S83E 16.8', 12" Elm (1/4S N8T) S52W 19.9'."

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(M3) Recovered the 1969 monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from both 1969 witness trees. Measured 2624.33' North and 2633.66' South to adjacent quarter corners. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Left the monument in place and marked two new accessories as described below. Corner recovered and witnessed by T.Stark and M.Feldpausch, Newberry District Office.

(M4) Recovered the 1969 monument, as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the stump remains of the 1969 witness trees. Neither have any visible markings. The monument was recovered 8.36' North of the record position: 2633.66' South and 2650.38' North of adjacent Section corners. This monument was used to control the subdivision of Section 12 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS, in 1980. I accept the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Left the monument in place and marked four new accessories as described below. Corner recovered and witnessed by T.Stark and M.Feldpausch, Newberry District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(M3) Found 1 1/4" iron pipe. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in the following:

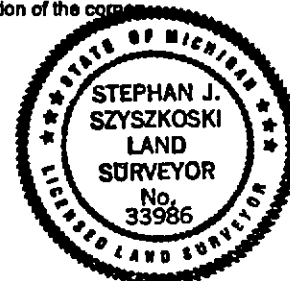
26" Maple N79W 42.15' "SI" (1969 wit)
 16" Maple N42W 51.5' "SI" (1969 wit)
 14" Maple N62W 76.0' "SI N8T"
 12" Maple N23W 65.3' "SI N8T"

Bearings are magnetic.

(M4) Found 1 1/4" iron pipe. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring nails in the following:

5" Maple N21W 23.9' "1/4S N8T"
 8" Elm S31W 25.3' "1/4S N8T"
 10" Elm S82W 19.0' "1/4S N8T"
 5" Maple N45E 30.1' "1/4S N8T"

Placed location tag on post N74W 13.4'.
 Bearings are magnetic.
