A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

J-13 Meander corner East of the South ¼ Corner of Section 35, T22N., R17W.

Established the South line of Section 35 using the Southeast Section Corner of Section 35 and the Northwest Corner of The Dunes Plat. Then measured the GLO distance West from the Southeast Section corner of Section 35, along the established South line, and set the monument.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

J-13 Meander corner East of the South ¼ Corner of Section 35, T22N., R17W.

On July 29, 1997, I installed a Manistee County Monument, flush to the ground and surrounded by rocks, at the same 14.18 chains distance West of the Southeast section corner of section 35, T22N., R17W. as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner, and witnessed by:

3. N 76° E 71.00' 18" Oak (Spike in the Southeast side)
4. N 41° E 59.82' 4" Aspen (Spike in the Southeast side)
5. S 68° E 57.40' 4" Oak (Spike in the Northeast side)
6. S 88° E 39.49' Concrete Monument (Northwest Corner of The Dunes Plat)

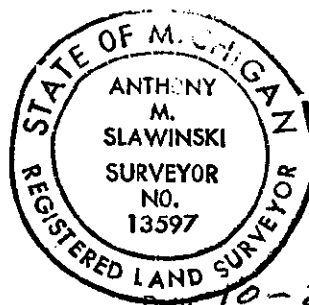
