Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Original survey established in 1838 by Sibley. II-3 Original Set a wooden post with the following references: Set a wooden grow trees: Beech 10" S46°E 5 lks. Bearing Beech 8" N72°W 43 lks.

In 1890, Manistee/Grand Rapids Railroad found corner, no new references. The following railroad information: Station 730+10.5 bears West 466.2 ft. of the corner. Station 736+23.5 bears South 386.4 ft. of the corner. Station 742+84 railroad intersect logging railroad.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found intersection of Manistee Railroad grade and lopging grade at station 742+84. Restored corner by measuring Northwesterly along center line of grade to Stations 736+23.5 and 730+10.5. From Station 736+23.5 measured North 386.4 ft. and from Station 730+10.5 measured East 466.2 ft. to restore corner position. Found pine stump with chop marks (chop marks facing the direction of corner) bears S24°E a distance of 12.0 ft. Found other pine stump 18" Dia. with chop marks (chop marks facing the direction of corner) bears N69°E a distance of 33.2 feet. H-3 Found monument described by Griffin. The position round monument described by Griffin. The position not accepted because of Railroad records and large deflection (over 5°) to North at corner. Found badly decayed cedar stump (accepted as BT to SW as GLO).

Set 2 1/2" dia. X 30" iron pipe with a brass cap stamped to identify the corner. Set fiberglass stamped to identify the corner. Set fiberglass 1.2 feet East of corner. The following corner references:

H-3 In 1979, K. Ross found 3/4" iron pipe 8 ft. from the Center line of grade.

In 1980, R. Griffin found 3/4" iron pipe and replaced it with 1 1/2" X 60" concrete filled iron pipe with brass cap (see corner certificate Liber 2, Page 86 in the Mason Co. Register of Deed's Office).

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
