B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;

1/4 Corner for Sections 23 & 26, T19N, R15W. J = 9

Due to the lack of any confirmed G.L.O. witnesses or other evidence and the lack of any old fences, the position of this corner was determined by locating and using the south end of the Historic West 1/16 line fence and then calculating an inverse between this location and the NW Corner of Section 26. I then calculated an inverse between the NW Corner and the NE Corner in Section 26, (5260.34 feet). I then calculated the Mid-point between NW Corner and the NE Corner of Section 26, (2630.17 feet) to determine the Easting position. I projected a line from the NW Corner of Section 26 through the West 1/16 fence corner, (Grid Bearing N 86°-56'-28" W) to intersect a line due South of this Mid-point to determine the Northing position of this 1/4 corner.

This position was presented to the Mason County Surveyors Peer Review Committee for discussion, and it was agreed that due to the lack of any confirmed evidence to the location of the original 1/4 corner, that holding to old occupation lines was best in this case. Condition of recorded witnesses is; #1 Gone #2 Gone #3 Gone #4 Gone Note; There is a previously file Act 74, on this Corner, file by Jack C. Schulke R.L.S. # 30894, see Liber 3, Page 91, Mason County Corner Records. Corner hears N 06°-56'-36" E a distance of 67.81 feet, from above position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set a $5/8^{\circ} \times 24^{\circ}$ Re-Rod with an aluminum cap stamp Mason county Monument, 2 $1/2^{\circ}$ in dia. And is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the orginal corner.
