MONROE COUNTY REMONUMENTATION PROGRAM

Peer Group approved corner on 11/08/1993 per Act 345 of 1990.

I, G.B. WARNKE, JR., in a field survey on 12/2/1994, 19 , do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-9, T8S, R7E, Section Corner Between Sections 19, 20, 29 & 30
(At Intersection of Dean & Secor Roads)

In 1820, G.L.O. Surveyor Joseph Wampler set corner post for Sections 19, 20, 29 & 30. Witnesses: B. Oak 9 inch N.41°E. 33 links & B. Oak 14 inch N.54°W. 63 links. / O.A. Case used railroad spike in May of 1942. / Case & Fleck witnessed & set nail 3-8-72. / A.J. Marino notes railroad spike in June of 1946. / G.B. Warnke used railroad spike & 12/18/92, per File No. 91-0473 notes bolt was found & referenced, area was excavated, found PK nail 1 inch deep & railroad spike 4 inches deep and set 1/2 inch iron pipe and witnessed.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C-9 - On 11-02-1993, found 1/2 inch capped iron pipe (No. 19474) and witnesses checked within reason to witnesses per noted G.B. Warnke Survey, File No. 91-0473. 12/2/1994, set 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside monument box to replace found iron.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C-9 - Set 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside monument box to replace found 1/2 inch capped iron pipe (No. 19474) and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and witnesses:

South 45° East 122.27' northwest corner of wood siding of building No. 8196
North 30° West 78.16' top nut of hydrant
South 50° West 83.25' northeast corner of concrete block building No. 8197
South 45° West 48.89' nail/washer in north face of telephone pole
North 50° East 44.75' nail/shiner in southeast face of utility pole
