B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1994- No original evidence found. C. Cummings in 1909 did not indicate any criginal evidence at this corner position as he ran the North line of Section 6 from the B.T. Corner at the NW Corner of Section 6 to the B.T. Corner at the NF Corner of Section 6. Set the corner proportionately on line between the NW and NE Corners of Section 6. SCA distance between section corners is 5171.27' as compared to the GLO distance of 5184.96' which is 13.69' short. Cummings mile distance is 5172'. DNR calculated mile distance is 5173.30'.
