I, GERALD W. CARLSON, in a field survey on DECEMBER 17TH, 19 96, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:  
L-11: Quarter Corner common to Sections 25 and 36.

1845: Sam U. Hill's original subdivision survey notes describe the corner monument as a wood post referenced by:

4" Alder N47E, 13 L 3" Alder S13W, 18 L

No Date (Circa 1900): Charles Cummings, in Record of Surveys Pg. 191, indicates the corner being equidistant on line between the Southwest and Southeast corners at a distance of 2673'.

No Date: (Circa late 1940's to early 1950's) MCRC field book number 698 indicate setting a Spruce post in a swamp 24 feet North of the North edge of a creek.

1949: A field sketch by R.A. Brotherton indicates the corner is 2673 feet Easterly of the Southwest Section Corner.

1990: A Survey Sketch by R.L. Jamros indicates a calculated position at the 1/4 Corner with no monument set. Jamros' 1/2 Mile Distance is shown as 2666.2' compared to an SCA Distance of 2669.72'. CCI triangulation coordinates indicate a distance of 2669.16'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

L-11: 1996: Searched and found no original or subsequent corner evidence. This corner was set equidistant and on line between the Northwest and Northeast Corners of Section 36. The position checked well with the 1942 M.C.R.C. call of "24' North of the North edge of a Stream." Distance East is 2669.72' and Distance West is 2669.72'.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

L-11: 1996: Set a 3/4" diameter by 6' long Iron capped with a 3 1/4" diameter aluminum tablet Marquette County Survey Monument stamped to identify the corner. Monument is flush with ground, and is 21.0' North of the North edge of a +/- 20' wide stream.
