I, GERALD W. CARLSON, in a field survey on October 19 TH, 2000, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

**NOTE:** Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

#### A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

**C-1: Section Corner common to Sections 5 & 6, T48N-R26W**

1846: Sam W. Hill's original subdivision survey notes describe the corner monument as a post 21 links West of the Corner Common to Sections 31 & 32, T49N-R26W referenced by:

Y. Birch	18"	S24E,	22 links
Y. Birch	28"	S67W,	72 links

1981: Robert E. Schmeling found a ½" dia. By 4' long iron pin and accepted it as the Section Corner Common to Sections 5 & 6, T48N-R26W and Sections 31 & 32, T49N-R26W, which is in error as the original GLO survey indicates double corners at the location. Mr. Schmeling verified this location by Original BT evidence he recovered, which witnessed the Corner Common to Sections 31 & 32. Mr. Schmeling did not recover the Yellow Birch witnesses listed above. Mr. Schmeling placed a 1" dia. By 4' long pipe with brass cap stamped to identify the corner over the found iron pin and established the following references:

#### B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

**C-1: 2000:** Found and accepted as the Corner Common to Sections 31 & 32, T49N-R26W the above described Schmeling monument. At the calculated position 13.75' West of the found monument a spike was placed and offset. The above listed GLO witnesses were measured: at Y. Birch, 18", S24E, 22 links - found 9" Hemlock with Y. Birch bark below it; at Y. Birch, 28", S67W, 72 links - found Y. Birch bark below surface. We then scraped away soil at spike and found a vertical piece of rotted wood 0.4' below surface and extending to a depth of 1.3'. This wood was badly decayed and had a slight curve at the bottom 3".

#### C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

**C-1: 2000:** At the spike location we set a 2 3/8" O.D. aluminum pipe capped with a 3 1/4" diameter aluminum tablet Marquette County Survey Monument stamped to identify the corner. Monument is 0.1' above ground and 89' +/- West of the centerline of Co. Rd. 510. Referenced by:
